Guests at the Event

1. Entry tickets to the event are \$10 per person. Refreshments, wine and non-alcoholic drinks will be available. Tickets may be purchased via the internet at www.catawbavalleypride.org or at the door while available—there are limited number of tickets. Catawba Valley Pride accepts cash, checks, and credit cards.
2. Obtain a **Bidder Number**.
3. Other games and activities may be available including a **50/50 raffle** (cash only).

The Auction

During the Silent Auction bidding period

1. When you see a dessert you wish to bid upon, write your **Bidder Number** and **Last Name** on the next available line of the bid sheet. If there is a Minimum Increment Amount listed at the top, please increase your dollar amount by that amount (or more).
2. You may bid on as many desserts as you wish and as often as you wish.
3. When the bidding period ends, the guest bidding the highest dollar amount is deemed the Winner of that item.

When the Silent Auction bidding period ends (around 7:30)

1. Please be patient and continue to enjoy the party.
2. Any items receiving no silent auction bids may be sold during a Live Auction at this time.
3. If a winning bidder is no longer present, the next highest bidder will be deemed the winner.
4. Bid sheets will be collected by auction officials and taken to the Check Out station for sorting.
5. **DO NOT** collect winning desserts until you have paid and been given a **Claim Sheet**.
6. All winning items must be collected and taken with you. Any items not collected will be disposed of at the discretion of the Catawba Valley Pride Board.
